DISCERNING A SECULAR FRANCISCAN DOCATION



Discernment is a <u>two-way street</u> [individual + fraternity: must await the leading of the Holy Spirit





Discernment is <u>not easy & the path is not straight</u>
[all concerned are led by God's Spirit]

But, in discernment <u>prayer</u> is the primary tool

Discernment is a process



SCRIPTURAL INSIGHTS IN THE TASK OF DISCERNING

Listen for the still small voice:

'...and after the fire a still small voice' [I K 19.12]

Be prepared to be emptied of preconceptions & biases:

'...the rich he has sent empty away' [Lk 1.53] Discern the source of the call:

'Then Eli perceived that the Lord was calling the boy' [I Sam 3.8] Be prepared to distinguish between God's voice & others:

'...test the spirits to see whether they are of God' [I John 4.1]

Be prepared for times of uncertainty:

'Some in the crowd shouted one thing, some another' [Acts 21.34] Be prepared for times of uncertainty:

'Some in the crowd shouted one thing, some another' [Acts 21.34] Be prepared to wait—it may seem slow:

'If it seems slow, wait for it, it will surely come' [Hab 2.3]

LOOK FOR OBSTACLES

- Individualism & competition
- Self-absorption
- Ambition
- Self-righteousness
- Need for control
- Difficulty with interpersonal relationships











POSITIVE SIGNS IN PROSPECTIVES

- Aware of needs of others
- Shows honourable motives for wishing to enter the Order
- Serenity despite turmoil in life
- Radiates joy
- Open to authentic relationship in fraternity
- Displays persistence & patience despite obstacles & impediments
- Accepted by fraternity; believes belongs there
- Filled with gratitude & love that does not fade with time







LOOK FOR PRIMARY ATTITUDES

- 1. Trust: 'Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not rely on your own insight.' [Prov 3.5]
- God is present
- God speaks to us
- God is loving & merciful
- **2. Listening**: 'Speak. Lord, for thy servant hears.' [I Sam 3.10]
- God speaks through everything
- We must listen with open minds & hearts
- Sometimes it is not what we want to hear
- **3. Prayer & Waiting:** 'Therefore the Lord waits to be gracious to you...blessed are those who wait for him.' [Isa 30.18]
- Prayer for discernment involves listening with total attention
- God's will is found in everything, so believing this means our whole life becomes a prayer
- **4. Scriptural Knowledge:** 'I have laid up thy word in my heart, that I might not sin against thee.' [Ps 119.11]
- Knowledge of God through Scripture
- Gospels: life to Gospel, Gospel to life
- **5. Humility:** 'For God abases the proud, but saves the lowly.' [Job 22.30]
- Humble person: neither too self confident nor too modest
- Humility—one of the foundation stones of discernment—accepts limits of human knowledge, willing to depend on God & others for help
- **6. Discipline, Perseverance, Patience, Perspective:** 'But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control...' [Gal 5.22f]
- Impulse is controlled by discipline
- Uncertainty mastered by perseverance
- Patience replaces irritation
- Perspective reminds us that it is to God's will that we are responding

NEGATIVE SIGNS IN PROSPECTIVES

- Overextended or exhausted
- Experiences inner turmoil, disturbances, sadness, depression
- Has pressing previous commitments that demand serious consideration, esp children, spouse
- Experiencing anxiety or obsessions; not in touch with God's presence
- Exhibits attitudes of absolute certainty, arrogance, superiority, vanity, irritability, resentment, condemnation, condescension
