9. Preparing for Elections

On various levels, each fraternity is animated and guided by a council and minister who are elected by the professed according to the constitutions. Their service, which lasts for a definite period, is marked by a ready and willing spirit and is a duty of responsibility to each member and to the community. Within themselves the fraternities are structured in different ways according to the norm of the constitutions, according to the various needs of their members and their regions, and under the guidance of their respective councils. Rule 21

You may ask, 'What sort of "skills" are we looking for in the people we elect'? Seldom will any one person have all or most of the following attributes—but possession of some of them is an indication of suitability as a leader in Franciscan life.

Discipline [faithfulness to prayer; perseverance]

Vision [insight; inspirer of vision in others]

Listening [often and long—without prejudgment]

Courage [meeting difficulty without discouragement]

Decision [taking responsibility based on sound premises]

Humility [sacrificial service; admitting frailty; only asking others to take on tasks

we would be prepared to do]

Integrity [transparent character; innocent of guile; loyal in service]

Humour [not afraid of being laughed at; relaxing tension by seeing the funny side

of things]

Inspirational [light for others; helping others to see their talents, their value]

Wisdom [discernment with the Holy Spirit]

Trust [in others, coming from a trust in God]

Collaboration [working with—always with others]
